Interventional Radiology Procedures

Arterial interventions

- Peripheral arterial disease (PAD) diagnosis and treatment, including arteriography, angioplasty, atherectomy, stent placement, thrombectomy, and thrombolysis
- Embolization of uterine artery for symptomatic uterine fibroids (UAE/UFE)
- Mesenteric artery angioplasty and stent placement
- Renal artery angioplasty and stent placement

Venous interventions

- Venous access – e.g., port-a-cath, tunneled and nontunneled central venous catheters, peripherally inserted central catheters (PICC)
- Inferior vena cava (IVC) filter placement and retrieval
- Thrombolysis and thrombectomy of venous thromboembolic disease, including deep vein thrombosis (DVT) and pulmonary embolism (PE)
- Dialysis access maintenance – fistulogram, de clot, balloon-assisted maturation
- Retrieval of intravascular foreign bodies
- Gonadal vein embolization for varicocele/pelvic congestion
- Transjugular intrahepatic portosystemic shunt (TIPS)
- Transjugular liver biopsy w/ intravascular pressure measurements
- Vein sampling, including adrenal and renal vein renin
- Venography of the upper and lower extremities
- Venous angioplasty and stent placement

Pain management

- Kyphoplasty and vertebroplasty for vertebral compression fractures
- Epidural steroid injection
- Intraarticular (joint) steroid injection
- Nerve block/neurolysis – celiac plexus, superior hypogastric plexus, sacrococcygeal plexus, intercostal nerves, et al.
- Migraine treatment – sphenopalantine ganglion block

Oncologic interventions

- Liver directed therapy – Yttrium-90 radioembolization
- Liver directed therapy – transarterial chemoembolization (TACE)/drug-eluting bead embolization (DEB-TACE)
- Percutaneous tumor ablation, including liver, kidney, lung

Genitourinary interventions

- Percutaneous nephrostomy, nephroureteral stent, and double-J ureteral stent placement
- Percutaneous suprapubic urinary drainage catheter placement

Biliary interventions

- Percutaneous transhepatic cholangiography with biliary drainage catheter placement
- Percutaneous cholangioplasty, lithotripsy, and endobiliary stenting
- Percutaneous cholecystostomy

Other interventions

- Image-guided percutaneous biopsy
- Image-guided percutaneous abscess/fluid collection drainage
- Percutaneous gastrostomy/gastrojejunostomy placement
